

Ages 5-6	K/1 st	This class will introduce students to the fun world of Greek! Students will learn the alphabet, numbers, colors, and conversational phrases. The use of song, movement, games, and arts and crafts will enhance learning and make this class fun and educational.
Ages 6-7	Beginning Greek	This class will focus on introducing students to the Greek language and culture. Students will review/learn the alphabet, numbers, days of the week, months, colors, writing and introductory conversational phrases and vocabulary. Students will learn in song class rules and basic interactive phrases. They will also be introduced to major Greek and Christian holidays and learn children's songs. Class will focus on all skills with an emphasis in oral production.
Ages 7 - 8	Elementary Level A1	In this class students will build vocabulary through themes including learning about the family, the house, school, clothes, animals, and the neighborhood. Students will learn how to follow and give instructions, write sentences and short paragraphs in Greek, and read short passages. They will also learn traditional children's songs and increase their understanding about major Greek and Christian holidays.
Ages 8-10	Elementary Level A2	In this class students will practice the necessary linguistic functions to be able to understand and produce orally and in writing basic communicative conversations. Students will work on grammatical functions including present verb tense, nouns and articles. Vocabulary themes include daily activities, family and friends, and basic descriptions of people and everyday life activities.
Ages 10-13	Elementary Level A3/A4	In this class students will continue improving on their oral and written production of Greek. Students will be introduced to grammatical functions including past and future verb tense, nouns and adjectives. Vocabulary themes include describing simple events in the past, describing plans for the future, describing people and events. Students will perform role-plays to enhance their comprehension and oral production of the Greek language.
	Elementary Level B1	In this class students are at a low- intermediate level of learning the Greek language. In grammar, students will continue to work on the past tense and future tenses, declensions of articles, nouns, and adjectives, prepositions and their different uses. In writing, students will work on developing paragraphs on various topics. They will also work on listening comprehension and more complex oral production of everyday conversational tasks.
	Elementary Level B2	In this class students will progress to a more complex use of the Greek language both in grammar and writing. They will also work on listening comprehension and more complex oral production of describing events and people in the present, past, and future.
Adult Classes	Beginning Greek	This is an introductory course in Greek for adults. Students will learn the fundamentals of the Greek language in all four skills, with greater emphasis given in oral production. If you always wanted to learn Greek or would like to be able to finally practice what you know and improve on your skills, this is the class for you.
