



The Meaning of Icons



The word Icon comes from the Greek word Eikon, which means image. St. Paul speaks of Christ as the Icon of God; as it is written in the original New Testament Greek. Christ is the Icon of God, and the whole New Testament is written on the basis that if you want to know what the Eternal God is like, you look at Jesus and see. In the Eastern church, the purpose of icons was to create reverence in worship, to instruct those who are unable to read, and to serve as a means to link the worshipper and God during Orthodox Christian worship.

The Hebrews strictly objected to any kind of painted image of God. Yet, at the same time, they never realized that a combination of letters conveying an idea was just as much an icon as any other form of portrayal of God. The early Christian Church had a need to express the idea of Christ embodied. Jesus had already been embodied in the written word and song. Eventually, He had to be embodied in picture in order to appeal to our sense of sight.

The best icons of God we have during the Divine Liturgy are the actual people present. This is why the priest not only censes the painted icons, but also the living icons; the faithful worshippers. Icons are theology in color. They remind us of the Incarnation of Christ and his triumph over sin and evil. The icons portray the two natures of Christ; God & Man. Icons of Saints portray the transfigured state of the saint who has been sanctified by God.

A few months ago, we began our own icon project. These icons will eventually be taken with us when we move into our own facility. In the meantime, we will create, to the best of our ability, a Church that practices Orthodox style worship; Liturgically and aesthetically. We began by putting drawings of the icons in the place where each belong. Each time an icon is sponsored, we will replace it with the full color icon. The image for the side wall icons will be chosen by the sponsor of that particular icon. Each icon will cost \$5,000 or \$6,000 depending on the image.
